Trail classes may run before lunch - Class ribbons 1st thru 5th – Rosette ribbon to highpoint champions

All horses must be qualified by 4-H, no stallions allowed. Any horse not under control will be excused. Riders will be disqualified if coached while showing. Tack changes must be made near the entry gate. Proper etiquette is required in the arena and on the show grounds. Inappropriate language or unsportsmanlike conduct may result in disqualification or loss of award. Boots, long pants and long-sleeved shirts in appropriate style for discipline are required. All participants must wear ASTM or SEI approved equestrian protective headgear with three-point harness when mounted or in arena. Riders cannot cross enter walk/trot classes and open classes. Walk/trot classes are only for beginner or novice riders. Juniors are age 8-13, seniors age 14+. Rail class with less than 3 riders may be combined but judged separately. Gymkhana will run after lunch. Riders are responsible for knowing the show rules. Please refer to the current Arizona State 4-H Horse Show Rulebook for rules.
